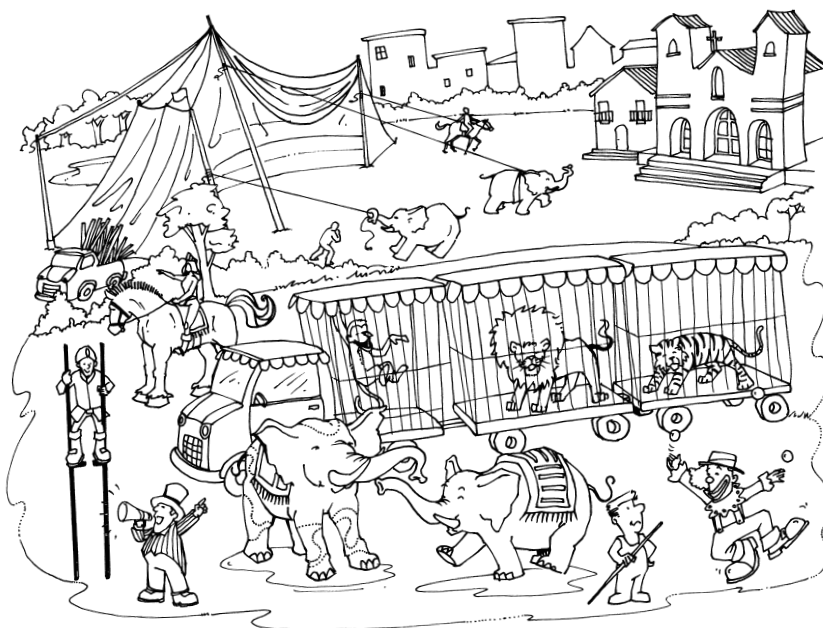


## 1. Read.

swung from one side of the tent to the other on a trapezoid”.



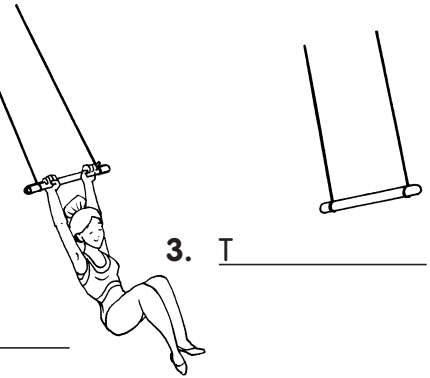

1. Read and match symbols and texts. Write the number next to the symbol.



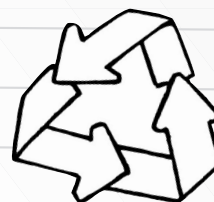
1. I represent the Olympic Games. I have five rings of five different colours. Each ring is one continent of the world. You will see this symbol in all Olympic Games.



2. When an object has this symbol, you know that you can use the object again and again.



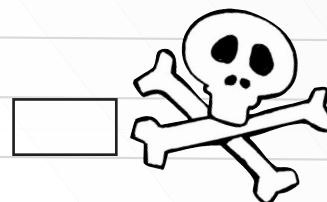
3. You will be lucky if you find me, especially if I have four leaves.
